



Dear **Sex Offender**

Subject: **The Rights you do not have in the constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996, see chapter two.**

First, we call you dear so that we soften you up to read and understand what we are about to say to you. Secondly, the name we gave you "Sex Offender" is for you to understand that your sexual desires are not romantic but offensive. Thirdly, we wrote you because we know you think you are smart, you will read and probably are reading this letter because you think you won but please know you didn't. In the past, you have clearly gotten away with these sick practices which, no one knows who taught you for crying out loud, raping, assaulting and sexually offending anything in your way. This is a clear sign you are not human, and you don't belong to be around us humans. If no one taught you any lesson about living amongst us, here is what we have to say to you:

1. You do not have a right to force another human being to do things that you would not want to be done to you.
2. You do not have a right to force yourself on another human being and for whatever reason.
3. You do not have a right to take what does not belong to you from any other human being just because you want it and you think you must have it or deserve it.
4. You do not have a right to take a life just because that human being denied you whatever you wanted and felt humiliated for not getting it.
5. You do not have a right to revenge on people just because life is not going your way or are not satisfied enough with what you have.

These rights that you violated in the past and now, or if you are thinking of sexually offending again, just because you cannot help it, kindly remember that the victims are your siblings, mother, father, nephew, nieces, grandchildren, aunt, grandpa, colleagues, fellow pupils and school mates, grandma or neighbour. We mentioned the above because we realise that you do not have limits or sense of humanity. The world consists of those people we mentioned.

Lastly, kindly note that you are not accepted by anyone in our community. You don't have a right to live amongst us. You have been doing this without shame or remorse, have you ever thought about how you will return to the community or face your family? How would you like to be received? Have you thought about that? You bring terror, fear and uncertainty to our community and most of all, you deprive us of freedom of association with others. We fear you, we hope this letter help you change your mind. We like, love and deserve to live in peace.
