For Travelling

Pack your luggage according to vital items you will need to use while on the road to avoid unpacking alongside of the road or highway.

When stopping at a garage, never leave the vehicle unattended: at least two people(adult) must stay while others go to bathrooms, vice versa.

Fasten all luggage if driving a Van/bakkie/pick-up truck. Make sure you locked your car every time you get in or out.

Refreshments

Ensure that no one consumes alcohol whilst driving with you, either as a passenger or the driver. Alcohol has unpredictable outcomes which might cause the intoxicated person to put you or him/her in danger from fighting or self injury in the process.

Consume as much water as you can, and encourage passengers to do so in case you are travelling with the sick and are unaware. Ask constant questions and look to check if everyone is alright or is falling ill.
